Read John 20:25.

WHAT AN AMAZING
RESPONSE FROM JESUS!

Let's continue reading in John 20:26-31.

Manifestation (or to make manifest) means "to make known; to show forth".

How has Jesus manifested Himself to you and through you?

And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us; and we saw His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. - John 1:14

Read Galatians 2:20 and Romans 1:28-31.

What is the evidence that Christ is manifested to us and in us? How are doubt and faith at work in your life?
