DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

Read 2 Chronicles 20:5–12. (The King's Prayer)
I may not know what tomorrow holds, but I know
who holds my tomorrow.

1. What stands out to you about the king's initial response and prayer when he hears the news of the enemy?

2. When have you prayed with urgency and surrender?

Read 2 Chronicles 20:15–17. (God's Answer)
“The battle is not yours, but God's.”

3. Discuss why God still calls us to take our position and stand firm even though the battle belongs to the LORD.

Read 2 Chronicles 20:18–23, 27–28. (The Worshipers Lead The Charge)

4. How does worship change your mindset or perspective?

Read Colossians 2:13–15.
