DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

Read 1 Kings 19:4-15.

To hear the whisper, you must remove the noise.

1. Why do you think God spoke in a whisper to Elijah?

Sacred silence calls us to be active, not passive.

APPLICATION

- Awareness of obstacles
- Your Bible
- Follow
- The Lord will give direction

2. Share a recent moment when you sensed God speaking to you.

Read John 10:1-4.

You can't say God is silent if your bible is closed.

3. Think of a time when you were listening to the wrong voice. What was the tipping point when you realized it, and what did you do about it?

4. Voices and sounds can be encouraging or distracting. Who or what was the loudest voice in your first 12 years of life? As a young adult? Currently?

GOING DEEPER - PAUSE, PONDER, PRAY

Read Matthew 7:13-14 and 2 Timothy 4:3. Small compromises are still compromises. The Gospel is a call to responsibility. Responsibility is our ability to respond to the Lord. What has your attention? What is your direction? What has your destination?
